

STAGE RIDER : AMFMS

Band Name: AMFMS

Pronounced: A.M.F.M. but plural, or possessive ... so ... AMFMs' (just trying to help!)

Overview for Sound Engineer / FOH head honcho.

- 5 Piece live music group, no computers, no canned tracks
- Every member (5) sings. Lead vocalist and Keyboardist both provide own microphones (supercardioid). All other members (3) will need microphones. All members (5) will need mic stands and clips. NO phantom power needed. Thanks!
- Mixing Notes: Early 70's rock
- Stage Center Right Vocal is Lead Vocal
- Stage Center Right Vocal & Keys Vocal to please be dry of effects aside light reverb by FOH.
- Keyboard / vocal will require a DI. *Keyboard and Keyboard Vocal are run through effects controlled by Keyboardist and will be provided to you as a summed mono single line input into the DI.*
- All other vocals (3) to **please be run with heavy vintage reverb** by FOH.
- Guitar amps are all lower wattage tube amps (15-20 watts) and will need to be mic'd. If stage volume is an issue please tell us to turn down, so you can control through the mains. We want to sound our best, and you know your room better than we do.
- Thank you, you are a badass, and have a tough gig. We really appreciate your effort, and will buy you a beer if you are thirsty. A band is only as good as their FOH.

STAGE LAYOUT

Stage Center Back = Drums / Backing Vocal (straight stand please if possible. If not, all good.)

Stage Far Left = Guitar / Backing Vocal

Stage Center Left = Bass (DI) / Backing Vocal

Stage Center Right = Guitar / Lead Vocal

Stage Far Right = Guitar / Keyboard / Backing Vocal

Input List

Mic Vocal (Center Rear, Drummer)

Mic Vocal (Stage Left Guitar)

Mic Vocal (Stage Center Left Bass Guitarist)

Mic Vocal (Stage Center Right Lead Vocal, Will Provide Own Mic)

DI for Keyboard / Vocal line input (Stage Right Keyboard/Guitar/Vocalist)

Mics for Standard 5 Piece Rock Drum kit

XLR for Bass Amp (has DI built in)

*note: "Hey drummer" or "Hey guitar player with the tacky jacket" also works.

Matt - Drums, Vocal

Kit - Guitar, Vocal Stage Left

Shawn - Guitar, Lead Vocal Stage Center Right

Brandon - Guitar, Keys, Vocal Stage Right
